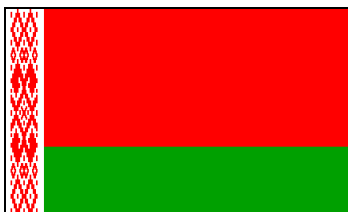

WINNERS – ZONE C QUALIFYING (d. Finland 3-0, Poland 3-0, Russia 2-1)

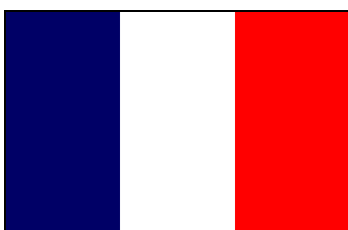
TEAM – Jessica Sabeshinskaja (#36), Christina Shakovets (#41), Dana Oppinger (#55)

FINALISTS – ZONE B QUALIFYING (Bye, d. Romania 2-1, lost Serbia 1-2)

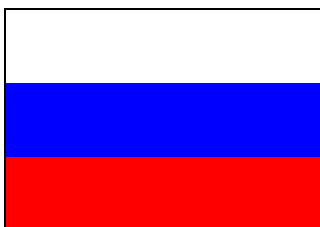
